The Summary of Benefits Letter confirms the veteran's eligibility for a free pass under State Law 2024-45. Eligible veterans with disabilities who receive an Annual Pass must follow the Annual Pass Program rules, regulations, and guidelines, including:

- > The Annual Pass holder must present the actual physical pass in order to be granted access to recreation areas or to utilize equipment rentals or boat launches.
- > Eligible veterans with disabilities must submit this form to the Division's headquarters along with a copy of their Summary of Benefits Letter to be issued a free pass. Staff at parks are not able to process these requests. Staff at parks cannot grant any benefits of the Annual Pass prior to the eligible veteran with disabilities receiving the pass from the Division's headquarters.
- > Passholders who do not bring their Annual Passes with them during their park visit are cannot redeem any of the pass benefits.
- > Lost or stolen passes will not be replaced.
- > Duplication of passes or transfer of passes to non-eligible individuals is prohibited.
- > Violation of state law and/or park regulations may invalidate the pass.
- > Eligible veterans with disabilities must submit a request every calendar year to receive the pass. Free passes will not be automatically sent to those who requested it previously.
